

Title: Acorn Pond

Grade: K-2

Overview: It's spring at Acorn Pond! And summer, autumn, and winter too! Here students see plants and animals as they appear throughout the year, hearing facts about animal growth and behavior. A "Field Notebook" with sketches and interesting information can be printed. Acorn Pond is modeled after a real pond in the upper Midwest of the United States.

My Learning Objectives:

Identify animals by attributes and habitat Recognize seasonal changes

DISCOVER MODE

- 1. Click the window with the pond to enter Acorn Pond from the Main Room.
- 2. Springtime at Acorn Pond appears.
- 3. Click the pictures on the screen to explore Acorn Pond.
- 4. To explore Acorn Pond in another season, click Spring, Summer, Autumn, or Winter.
- 5. Click anywhere on the water to discover what is in the pond. Then, click a plant or an animal to see an animation or to hear information.
- 6. Click any animal and then click the Field Notebook to see notes about that animal. To see notes about other animals, click the left or right arrow.
- 7. Adults may want to read the Field Notebook to children who are not yet reading. It contains interesting facts and helpful sketches.
- 8. Click the printer to print the notes shown. Once printed, the notes can be colored and used as posters. Or, staple several pages of printed notes together to make a booklet.
- 9. Click the closed field notebook to close the Field Notebook and return to Acorn Pond.
- 10. Click the character in the picture frame for Question and Answer Mode, or click Sammy to return to the Main Room.

QUESTION AND ANSWER MODE

- 1. Click the character in the picture frame to enter Question and Answer Mode.
- 2. Olivia, the owl, asks you a question about one of the pond animals, for example: "Whooo lays eggs?"
- 3. Click an animal to answer the question. If you forget the question, click Olivia.
 - If you answer correctly, Olivia tells you; for example, "Right. The robin lays eggs."
 - If you answer incorrectly, Olivia repeats the question, and you can try again.
- 4. To hear questions about the animals of Acorn Pond in another season, click Spring, Summer, Autumn or Winter.
- 5. Click the empty picture frame for Discover Mode, or click Sammy to return to the Main Room.
