

Title: Make-A-Movie

Grade: K-2

Overview: Lights! Camera! Action! Students arrange pictures in sequences to make

movies. Students can run their movies forward and backward.

My Learning Objectives:

Apply logic to order pictures in series Recognize change in physical properties

QUESTION AND ANSWER MODE

- 1. Click the movie projector to enter the Make-A-Movie from the Main Room.
- 2. Ramón, the rabbit, is trying to make a movie and needs your help.
- 3. Click the three-frame film strip to make a three-picture movie, or click the four-frame film strip to make a four-picture movie.
- 4. Click the rewind or forward button to see a new set of pictures.
- 5. Drag the pictures into the empty movie frames so that the pictures are in sequence. (If you change your mind about the arrangement of the pictures, just drag the pictures again.) Then, click Ramón.
 - If the pictures are in sequence, Ramón runs the projector in the theater.
 - If the pictures are not in sequence, Ramón helps you put them into the correct order.
- 6. To watch the movie run forward in the theater again, click the forward arrow. To watch the movie run backward, click the backward arrow.
- 7. Click Ramón to make a new movie.
- 8. Click Sammy to return to Sammy's Main Room.
