

Title: Culture Festival

Grade: K-2

Overview: It's a festival of fun! Visit four different houses to learn about the flag, foods,

clothing, and music of Germany, Tanzania, Mexico, and Japan.

My Learning Objectives:

Know some customs of various cultures around the world Recognize and locate selected countries on globe

DISCOVER MODE

Visit the festival to learn about four different countries! The festival features four houses from different countries: Germany, Tanzania, Mexico and Japan.

- 1. Click on the Piñata to advance to the Culture Festival Activity from the Main Room.
- 2. Click on a house and the globe. Click on the different objects surrounding each house to learn about them: flag, foods, clothing, and music. Click on an object and the camera zooms into a close up view.
- 3. When you click on a house, the globe spins to reveal that country, which is highlighted. A map of the country appears on the scrapbook.
- 4. Click the character in the picture frame for the Question and Answer Mode, or click Trudy to return to Trudy's Main Room.

QUESTION AND ANSWER MODE

- 1. Click the character in the picture frame to advance to the Question Mode. Bee greets you and invites you to collect things from the festival for her Scrapbook. She asks questions about each country. For example: Germany
 - In which country do men wear lederhosen?
 - Lederhosen are worn in which European country?
 - Find the doll wearing lederhosen for the scrapbook.
- 2. Click on a house to answer. Click again to get a closer view, then click on the object and drag it into the scrapbook.
 - If correct, Bee tells you to add the object to the scrapbook.
 - If incorrect, the object is identified and Bee asks you to try again.
- 3. Click on the Back Arrow to return to the main view.
- 4. Click on the Arrow buttons on the Scrapbook to see the collected objects.
- 5. Click the empty picture frame for the Discover Mode or click Trudy to return to Trudy's Main Room.
